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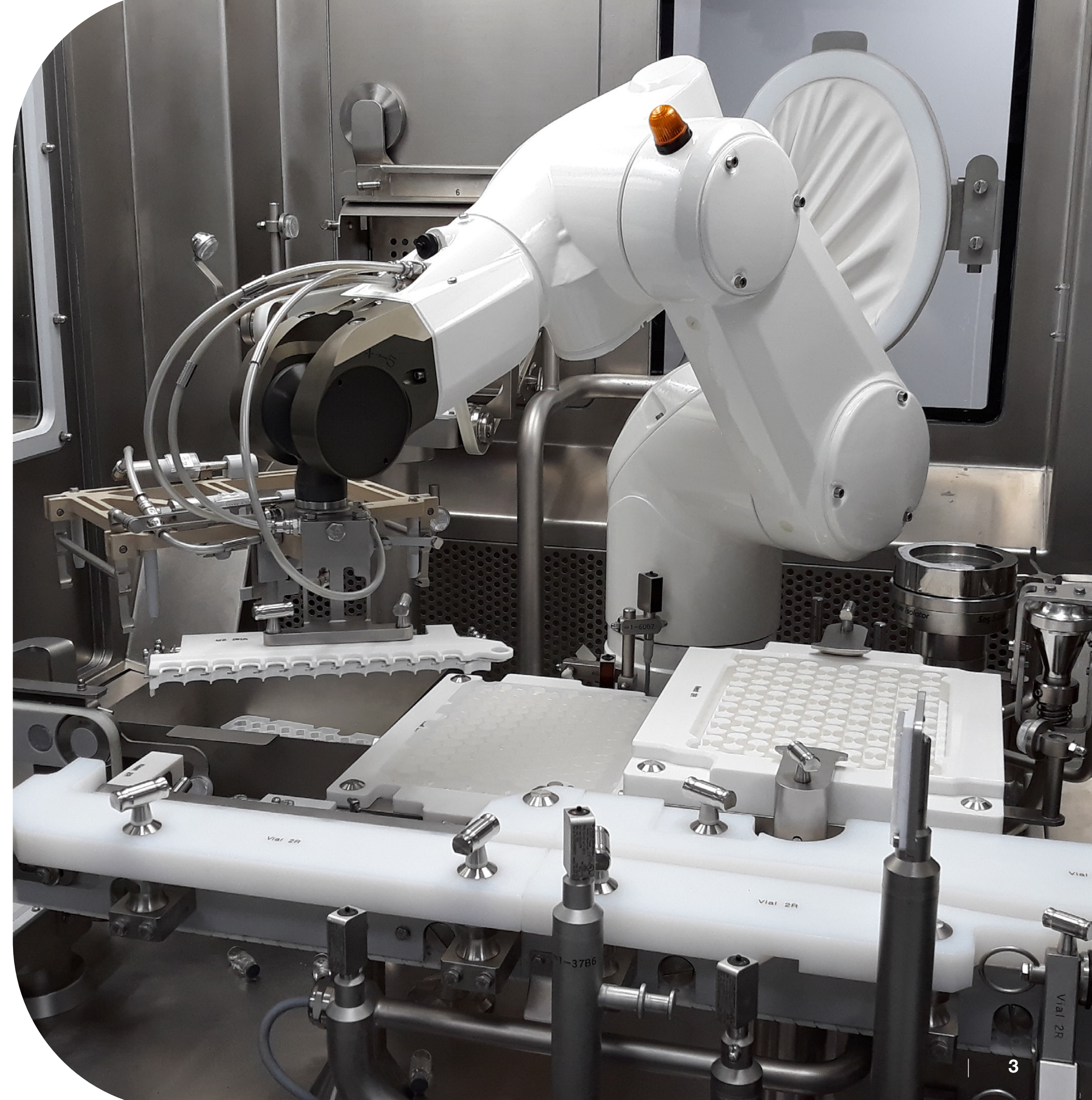

In pharmaceutical manufacturing, isolators play a vital role in protecting product quality and patient safety. They are designed to create highly controlled environments where contamination risks are tightly managed and evidence of control is essential.

Environmental monitoring within isolators should support this goal, not complicate it. Yet for many projects, monitoring becomes a source of delay, complexity and risk, particularly when multiple systems, suppliers and integration steps are involved.

Why monitoring matters in isolators

Isolators are typically designed to provide a Grade A environment, where the highest levels of contamination control are required. By physically separating operators from critical processes, they reduce risk, but only when environmental conditions are continuously monitored and understood. Some important considerations of isolator monitoring are:



EU GMP Annex 1 makes clear that Grade A environments must be continuously monitored for both viable and non-viable particulates. **Monitoring is therefore not optional; it is a defined regulatory expectation.**



Environmental monitoring provides the data and evidence needed to demonstrate that isolator conditions remain within defined limits. This supports sterility assurance, enables informed decision-making and **underpins patient safety.**

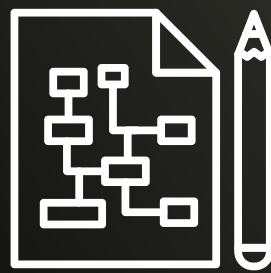


Effective isolator monitoring is not just a technical requirement. It is a foundational element of a **robust quality strategy**, one that must be reliable, repeatable and aligned with regulatory expectations from day one.



Challenges without a turnkey solution

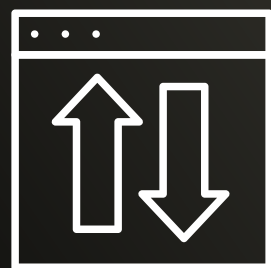
When isolator monitoring is delivered through fragmented systems and multiple vendors, complexity quickly increases.



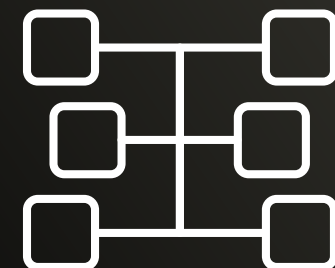
Projects often involve bespoke integrations, disconnected responsibilities and duplicated effort across suppliers. This can lead to delays during installation and qualification, inconsistent documentation and increased risk during validation.



Over time, these challenges can impact not only compliance confidence, but also operational efficiency and long-term system performance. What should be a controlled, predictable element of the isolator becomes another variable to manage.



Without a coordinated approach, teams may face extended project timelines, unexpected costs and greater downtime, particularly when changes are required or issues arise post-installation.



A lack of integration doesn't just slow projects down, it introduces uncertainty where certainty is essential.



The turnkey IMS advantage

A turnkey integrated monitoring system (IMS) brings monitoring, integration and compliance together as a single, coordinated system.

Rather than managing multiple suppliers and bespoke interfaces, teams receive a pre-engineered approach designed to work as part of the isolator environment from the outset.

At the centre of Pharmagraph's turnkey isolator monitoring approach is enVigil IMS, a proven integrated monitoring system designed for critical, regulated environments. With enVigil IMS, coordination extends beyond software alone. The platform is hardware agnostic, with in-built drivers for all major particle counter and viable air sampling brands. This enables isolator manufacturers to integrate with enVigil IMS once and deploy a consistent environmental monitoring system across projects, regardless of the end user's preferred equipment vendor.

Unlike many monitoring approaches, where each particle counter brand operates its own proprietary software and integration requirements, enVigil IMS provides a single, validated platform. This removes the need to manage different monitoring software environments on every project and significantly reduces engineering variation.

A turnkey approach replaces uncertainty with clarity, allowing isolator manufacturers to standardise their monitoring offer while retaining the flexibility their clients expect.

enVigil IMS operates in the background of the isolator system architecture. It feeds alarms and status information directly to the isolator HMI, ensuring operators interact with a single, unified interface. Monitoring data is synchronised to support batch reporting, audit trails and lifecycle documentation without adding additional operator burden.



Rather than requiring separate software environments for each monitoring device, enVigil IMS consolidates environmental data into a single validated platform, maintaining consistency across projects and sites.

Pharmagraph also operates with a dedicated IMS team. The same specialists work collaboratively with isolator manufacturer engineering teams from design through commissioning and validation. This continuity builds strong working relationships, reduces miscommunication and ensures monitoring is aligned with the mechanical and control system architecture from the outset.
